## 2024 Scholar-in-Residence: Maggid Marques Hollie



Marques (he/they) is an operatically-trained vocalist, ritual leader, and theatre maker, who has been telling (and singing!) stories for as long he can remember. Marques believes that Jewish practice and ritual are expansive, resilient containers and they enjoy exploring their identities as a Queer, Black, Jewish person through original songs and niggunim, liturgy, and theatrical work. Following a two-year course of study, Marques received ordination as a Maggid (sacred storyteller), and is a rabbinical student at the Reconstructionist Rabbinical College.
